Tsen has been involved in some of the largest energy transactions that have come to market in Australia, including significant PPP and economic infrastructure projects, the recent privatisation of the NSW transmission and distribution companies, and project financings in both thermal and renewable assets. In addition, Tsen has previously managed relationships with a range of Queensland based energy clients such as ERM Power, Energy Developments Limited, and Intergen Australia, before being appointed to

his current role where he has assumed broader responsibility to help steer the bank through the opportunities and risks of the energy transition.

Tsen will speak about the key influences and drivers of a financier's role, responsibilities, and aspirations in this regard, as the ANZ pivots towards a low carbon energy future. Tsen will also provide observations on current financing trends and innovations, capital markets and credit considerations.

Tsen is Malaysian Chinese by heritage, and was brought up in Kuala Lumpur and Perth. He holds a Bachelor of Law and Commerce degree from Murdoch University in Perth and a Master of Applied Finance from the University of Melbourne.
