Kathy Danaher is Vice Chairwoman of Ark Energy Corporation and a company director of Sun Metals Holdings Limited, Sun Metals Corporation Pty Ltd, Townsville Logistics Pty Ltd and Townsville Marine Logistics Pty Ltd.

Kathy has also held senior Australian and Asia Pacific financial, commercial and treasury roles with the global oil company BP and is currently serving on the Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) reliability panel. She is also a Director of Townsville Enterprise, an organisation that facilitates regional economic development in North Queensland.

Most recently, Kathy was Chief Financial Officer of Sun Metals Corporation Pty Ltd and has over 30 years' financial and business management experience in resource and energy markets, including oil, base metals and renewable energy development. At Sun Metals, Kathy helped deliver its \$200 million solar farm development, acquire a 30% stake in the 932.4 MW/\$1.5 billion Macintyre wind farm exercisable at Final Investment Decision and was integral in the \$450 million expansion of the operations for Sun Metals in Townsville.

Ark Energy Corporation is an Australian subsidiary of Korea Zinc Company Ltd, the largest zinc, lead and silver producer globally. Its mandate is to decarbonise the energy supply of the Korea Zinc group, starting with the Sun Metals zinc refinery in Townsville as it aims to become the first refinery in the world to produce green zinc.

Kathy will speak about the future of hydrogen in Australia and address some of the challenges that need to be overcome for the industry to succeed. Kathy will draw on her experience, being part of a leadership team in one of the most energy-intensive industries in the world that oversaw investment in and movement towards renewable energy in the form of solar, wind and hydrogen and a commitment to RE-100, one of the first refineries in the world to do so.

In addition, Kathy will outline some of Ark Energy's strategies as well as the driving need for Australia to be a leader in renewable energy and outline some of the key areas of focus for industry.

Kathy holds a Bachelor of Science Degree, Honours Degree in Marine Biology and a Bachelor of Business with a Major in Accounting. She is a Certified Practising Accountant (CPA Australia).
