David Wrench is the Chief Executive Officer of QPM Energy, an ASX listed company which owns the Moranbah Gas Project and dispatches electricity into the grid via the Townsville Power Station and Moranbah Power Station.

With a proven track record of technical and commercial innovation, David has more than 25 years' experience as a managing director of both private and publicly listed companies in the energy and finance sectors.

David was also the founding director of CH4 and responsible for establishing and developing the Moranbah Gas Project in Central Queensland. He initiated and completed commercial and joint venture agreements, developed commercial gas production and reserves and financed the project development.

Queenslanders love solar and air conditioning. Over the past decade,

the enormous increase in rooftop and grid scale solar capacity combined with the prevalence of air conditioning in Queensland homes, is reshaping the wholesale electricity market. With early evening peak demand hitting new records just as solar generation disappears, Queensland wholesale electricity prices are now one of the most volatile markets in the world.

Aging coal fired generators are struggling to keep up and gas is now being recognised by Federal and State governments as critical to support Queensland's ongoing energy transition. QPM Energy owns the Moranbah Gas Project and a growing portfolio of gas fired generation - ideally positioned to play a significant role in Queensland's energy market into the future.

David has a Bachelor's Degree, Mining (1st Class Honours), from The University of Sydney.
